Purpose: The Chambers Family Foundation is a private, non-profit foundation based in beautiful Eugene, Oregon. The foundation awards grants to residents and organizations throughout Oregon's Lane, Benton and Deschutes Counties – building stronger communities through the support of arts, education, medical, health, and human needs. The Foundation gives priority to projects and programs targeted by members of the Chambers Family Foundation in the fields of arts, education, medical, health, and human needs. For larger requests (over \$5,000) preference is given to specific projects over general operating support; prevention over rehabilitation; underlying causes for concern rather than short term symptoms; and independent charitable organizations over traditionally taxpayer-supported organizations.

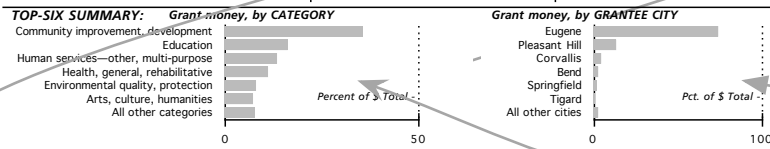
Restrictions: Generally, the Foundation will not fund, and only in exceptional circumstances will it be able to consider, requests in the following areas: pass-through agencies; capital construction projects; environmental projects; grants for basic research; grants loans to individuals; general fund-raising drives. No more than one grant per organization per year.

Geographic Focus: Lane County (90%), Benton County (5%), Deschutes County (5%).
Deadlines: Proposals may be submitted at any time, but must be received in their entirety by March 31 or September 30 of each year-to be considered at the next Trustees' meeting.

Published Info: To apply, complete two-page Grant Application form and attach narrative proposal and/or letter to clarify grant request; detailed budget for the project; include other sources of funding not being requested from the Foundation; include copy of 501(c)(3); list of board of directors; financial statements or most recent 990 tax return.

Other Info: Application form. (Note: The Foundation's designation for a capital grant is different than the DataBook's; some grant listings below do not meet the Foundation's designation.)
